

International Scientific Meeting for PIK3CA Related Conditions: Embargo Policy

All meeting attendees, members of the media, companies, institutions, organizations, universities, investment advisors, and all other individuals are required to abide by the embargo policy governing the CLOVES Syndrome Community virtual International Scientific Meeting for PIK3CA Related Conditions, 2021.

An embargo means that information from any abstract or presentation is confidential and may not be announced, publicized, or distributed before the embargo date and time. This policy applies to all formats of release. The purpose of the embargo policy is to protect the scientific integrity of the abstract submissions presented during this meeting. All submissions are to be considered preliminary until the time of presentation or are authorized for public release.

For oral presentations: Abstracts selected for oral presentation are embargoed from the time of submission until conclusion of the presentation at the meeting.

For poster presentations: Abstracts selected for poster presentation are embargoed from the time of submission until Tuesday, October 26, 2021 at 5pm EST.

Violation of the embargo policy by release of information contained in any abstract prior to its embargoed date and time will result in the individual, as well as the employer/affiliated company, institution, organization, being removed from the meeting sessions.
